Delivering quality healthcare close to home is the single most important contribution we make. But there are many other ways we make a positive impact on the communities we serve. Here are a few of the ways we are making a difference.

More than \$1.3 million in capital improvements

In 2010, we began a room renovation project which will upgrade our patient care rooms. We added two new chemistry analyzers in our Laboratory Department, along with some renovations to create a more coordinated process. We also added a computerized tracking tool which allows the technologist and technicians the ability to monitor a patient's test, as it is processed, in real time. This method of patient and test tracking was also implemented in our emergency department. All of these improvements are patient-focused attempts to decrease wait time and improve efficiencies. We also provided a number of upgrades in the area of surgical services.

In fact, we invested over \$1.3 million in our facility last year which included this new technology, upgrades, and additions mentioned above.

Contributing to our local tax base

Last year, Wythe County Community Hospital paid \$472,593 in property and sales taxes that helped support our city, county and state.

These dollars help support local schools, the development of roads, the recruitment of business and industry, and other vital community services.

Helping those in need

Wythe County Community Hospital provided \$62 million in uncompensated care last year, which included the amounts not covered by Medicare and Medicaid. This amount includes \$7.9 million for charity care and bad debts, incurred as we served many people without the financial resources to pay for basic health services.

Adding new physicians

During 2010, Wythe County Community Hospital welcomed three new physicians to our community, including specialists in urology, and two family medicine physicians to our highly respected medical staff. We continue to meet the needs of our community by recruiting physicians in the areas of obstetrics/gynecology, general surgery, orthopedics and family medicine.

With an annual payroll of more than \$22.8 million and 308 employees, Wythe County Community Hospital is one of the largest employers in the region. "Charity and other uncompensated care" includes the amounts not covered by Medicare and Medicaid as well as charity care and bad debts. "Physician recruitment costs" include recruitment costs and support of new physicians' initial practice establishment in the community. Payroll includes consolidated salaries, wages, benefits and contract labor costs. "Capital investments" include facility expansions/renovations, equipment purchases, technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and routine facility upkeep and maintenance.
